Drivers and Diversity of Chinook Salmon in the Arctic-Yukon-Kuskokwim Region

Recent declines in the abundance of many Chinook salmon populations have caused severe hardship in the Arctic-Yukon-Kuskokwim region. Given the rapidly changing ecosystems in this region, it is important to understand how conditions in freshwater and marine environments impact Chinook salmon productivity throughout their life cycle and whether populations respond synchronously or asynchronously to conditions across watersheds. To address this problem, we quantified the effects of environmental and ecological drivers on the produc-

tivity of 26 Chinook salmon populations in the AYK. Some drivers were associated with the productivity of individual watersheds. Other drivers, such as summer sea surface temperature, impacted the productivity of most population units similarly throughout the entire region. Our results highlight the diversity in salmon-environment relationships across the AYK.
